Charles Patrick "Pat" Murphy of Arcadia, MO, passed away on Wednesday, September 30, 2020 at the age of 63 years, 9 months, and 17 days. He was born Dec. 13, 1956 in Ironton, Mo, a son of the late Charles Daniel and Mary (Betty) Elizabeth Riley Murphy. Pat was a 1975 graduate of Arcadia Valley High School and a member of Ste. Marie Du Lac Catholic Church. He was the Manager of Murphy Dairy until it closed, and later became a millwright for Procter and Gamble. Pat was the quintessential Irishman, loved everything Irish, was quick to tell a story and an irreverent joke. Whether you had 4 legs or 2 legs, he demonstrated compassion for those in need to ensure a bed, meal or home were provided.

Surviving are four sisters: Ann Bond (Denny) of Beaumont, TX; Mary Patton (Michael Biggers) of St. Louis; Elizabeth Jefferys of Pikeville, KY; and Martha Hawn (Bill) of Waterloo, IL; 12 nieces and nephews; his special friend Mary Tiefenauer, and her daughter "little" Mary , and many other relatives and friends.
