



Rev. Everett Warren Kitchen

March 31, 1918 - October 19, 2020

Rev. Everett Warren Kitchen of Ironton, MO passed away in Farmington, MO at the age of 102 years, 6 months, 19 days. He was born March 31, 1918 in Graniteville, MO, a son of the late Charles and Emma (McGill) Kitchen. In 1941 Everett was united in marriage to Nina Bernice (Crocker) Kitchen who precedes him in death. Surviving Everett are five children; Elaine Keenan of Bismarck, MO, James (Karen) Kitchen of St. Louis, MO, Burlin (Garner) Kitchen of Bismarck, MO, Marilyn (Bill) Laws of Farmington, MO, Sandra (Jim) Brewer of Ironton, MO, eleven grandchildren, thirty great-grandchildren, fourteen great great-grandchildren, and a host of other loving family members and friends.
