Frank Eugene Tyndall, formerly of Bismarck, MO, entered into rest on Monday, October 21, 2024, at the age of 88 years, 11 months, and 14 days. He was born November 7, 1935, a son of the late Frank Joseph and Pearl Eunice (Dennison) Tyndall.

Frank was one of eight children and a loving brother to two brothers, Donnie Tyndall and Leroy Tyndall, and five sisters, Hilda Tyndall, Daisy Mae Tyndall, Judy Tyndall, Joyce Faye Cochran, and Gracie Tyndall.

As a young man, Frank enlisted in the United States Navy and served his country with pride and honor during the Korean War. After his service (of which he was very proud), he worked many years in construction, having a hand in many projects and buildings which still stand today. Frank was always a fun person to be around; always full of stories and he knew how to make people laugh. He enjoyed sitting at the Sit-n-Bull Barber Shop in Ironton, telling stories and drinking Doc's coffee, visiting with friends at the local restaurants, and driving his Crown Victoria (his pride and joy) all over town.

Frank Tyndall was a loving brother, cousin, and friend. He will be missed by all
