Gordon J. Lewis of Fredericktown, MO passed away April 14, 2013 at the age of 64 years. He was born June 13, 1948 in Adrian, MN, a son of the late Frank and Catharine Thormon Lewis.

On Aug. 21, 1991 he was united in marriage to Jenny Jones, who survives.
