



## Jacquelyn Sue Parmer

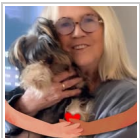

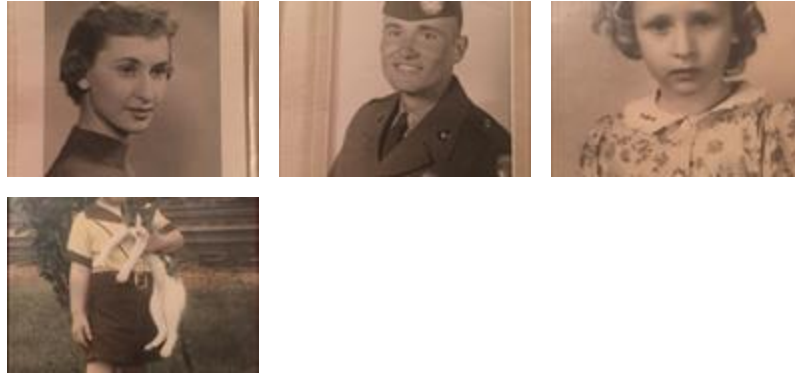
