Logan had a strong love for the Lord and wasn’t afraid to show it to everyone. He was always the sunshine on a cloudy day and his smile would brighten the darkest of days. 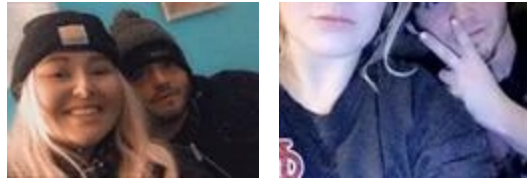
