



DR. Marvin C. Menne MD

October 25, 1926 - March 29, 2019

Dr. Marvin C. Menne of Arcadia, MO passed away March 29, 2019 in Ballwin, MO at the age of 92 years, 5 months, and 4 days.

He was born Oct. 25, 1926 in St. Louis, MO, a son of the late Lawrence and Ellen Hill Menne.

On June 7, 1952 he was united in marriage to Patricia McGartland, who preceded him in death on Jan. 2, 2005.

To this union was born four children; Mary King and husband Kevin of Manchester, Michael Menne and wife Diane of High Ridge, Gerri Jeffery (husband Steve Jeffery) and Diane Menne. Both Gerri and Diane preceded him in death.

Other survivors include 8 grandchildren, 10 great Grandchildren, soon to be 11, two brothers, Larry and Greg Menne both of St. Louis, and many nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

Dr. Menne graduated from CBC High School, and graduated from St. Louis University with an undergraduate degree and his Medical degree in 1952.

During WWII he served his country in the United States Navy.

He was a member of Ste. Marie du Lac Catholic Church, Arcadia Valley Elks, Missouri Community Betterment Assn. and served as Chairman of the Iron County Health Board for over 50 years.

He began his Medical practice in Ironton in 1955 and treated residents and delivered many babies for over 45 years.

He was a devoted Husband, Father, Grandfather, Great Grandfather,

Physician and friend to many.

Funeral Mass will be held on Sat. April 6 at 10 AM from Ste. Marie du Lac Catholic Church. Visitation will begin on Friday from 4 to 8 PM, with Rosary at 7 PM at Cole Family Funeral Home.
