Rev. Ronald Day of Farmington, MO, formerly of Ironton, MO, passed away May 25, 2016 at the age of 75 years, 1 month, and 16 days.

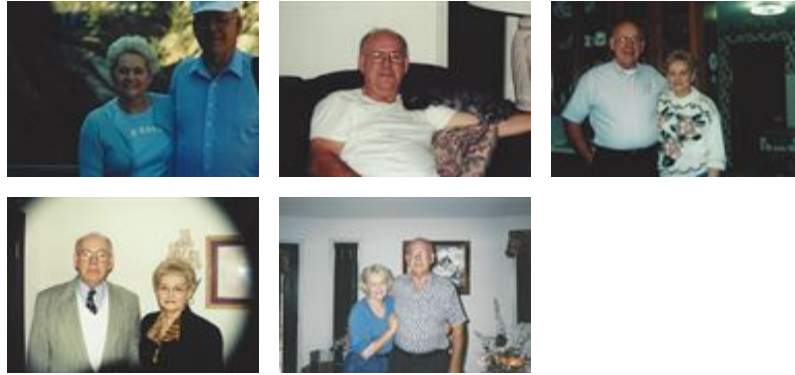
