Thomas Wayne Crowell of Arcadia, MO passed away Feb. 23, 2013 at his residence at the age of 56 years.

He was born March 29, 1956 in East St. Louis, IL, a son of the late Thomas and Gloria May Buckhannon Crowell.

On Jan. 17, 1981 he was united in marriage to Margot A. Wrigley who survives. To this union was born two daughters; Candace Mickan and husband J. L. of Farmington, and Lauren Colyott and husband Nathan of Cedar Hill.
