



## Victor Herman White

August 5, 1930 - August 29, 2015

Victor "Vic" H. White of Annapolis, MO passed away Aug. 29, 2015 at his residence at the age of 85 years, and 22 days.

He was born Aug. 5, 1930 in Mineral Point, MO a son of the late Benjamin and Hallie Tullock White. On Aug. 15, 1959 he was united in marriage to Carmil "Candy" Pierce who survives. Also surviving are two children, Sandy white and companion Eddie Wilson of Annapolis, and Kenny White and companion Sherry of Desloge; a grandson Dustin Sanders and wife Amy, three other grandchildren, 10 great grandchildren and many other relatives and friends. 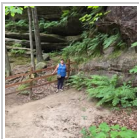
