James Waide Goggin of Ironton, MO, passed away Nov. 27, 2015 in Festus, MO at the age of 51 years, 5 months, and 19 days.

He was born June 8, 1964 in Ironton, MO, a son of James and Virginia Waide Goggin.

On May 20, 1995 he was united in marriage to Deborah Hensel who survives. 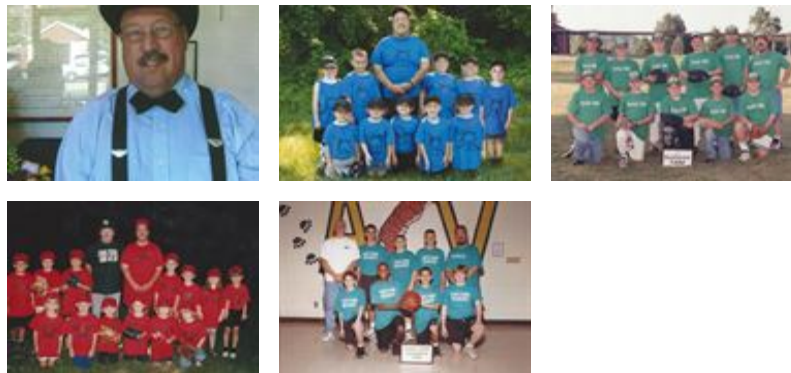

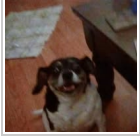
